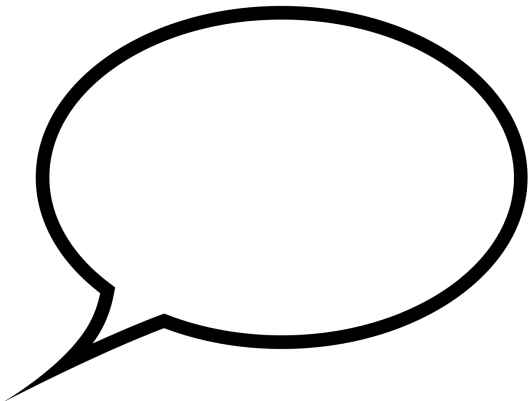


Social Problem Solving Scenarios
